Philip Edgcumbe is a Canadian scientist, biomedical engineer, medical innovator, physician-in-training (MDPhD) and entrepreneur. By connecting medicine, biomedical research, and entrepreneurship, *Philip is striving to have a positive impact on the health of a billion people.*

In 2017, Philip led a team which developed an XPRIZE global crowdsourcing competition to end Alzheimer's. He has invented and licensed a medical device and has been part of three biomedical start-up companies. In 2014, Philip was the recipient of the Outstanding Young Scientist award at the Medical Image Computing and Computer-Assisted Intervention (MICCAI) international conference. In 2016, he spent the summer in Silicon Valley at Singularity University where he studied exponential technology and medical innovation. In 2017, he received the Canadian Medical Hall of Fame Award and in 2019 he received the Canadian Medical Association Young Leader Award, CFMS-MD Financial Management Leadership award and Joule Emerging Physician Innovator award.
